Allergies Are Upon Us!

As the weather gets warmer allergen counts start rising. Many people experience runny nose, itchy eyes/throat, sneezing, and drainage with a sore throat. Allergies may cause increased asthma symptoms. Talk to your child's doctor about a daily over the counter allergy medication like Zyrtec, Allegra, or Claritin. These can be purchased for less than \$5 and can keep your student healthy and ready to learn!

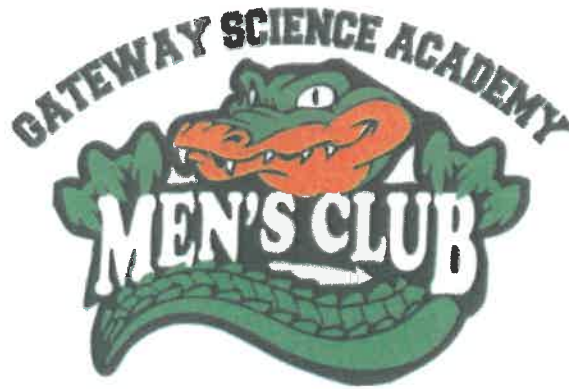
