School Profile 2021-2022

ENROLLMENT: Total 357 students in grades 9-12, including 60 seniors; 83 juniors; 96 sophomores; and 118 freshmen.

ACCREDITATION: GSA is a public charter school accredited by the Missouri State Board of Education and holds membership in the College Board and the National Association for College Admission Counseling.

SCHOOL ORGANIZATION: Eight 44-minute periods daily, two semesters, 18 weeks each.

COMMUNITY: St. Louis is a major city in Missouri along the Mississippi River. GSA opened its doors to freshmen in August 2012 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 2016.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS: Students must complete a min. of 28 credits that include the following requirements.

CURRICULUM:

Grading: GSA calculates grade point average on a **weighted 4.0** scale. (+, - included on a weight scale.)

The following breakdown is used:

A+= 4.00, A= 4.00, A-= 3.67, B+=3.33, B=3.00, B-=2.67, C+=2.33, C=2.00, C-=1.67, D+=1.33, D=1.00, D-=1.00, F=0.

Honors, AP and Dual Enrollment courses are weighted by one point. Students must pass a course with a D (60). Failing grades are entered on transcript and included in GPA calculations.

Rank: GSA does not rank students in its graduating class.

Honor Courses: Honors Algebra I, Honors Algebra II, Honors Geometry, Honors English II, Honors English I, Honors Biology, Honors Chemistry, Honors Physics, Honors World History, Honors U.S. History, Honors Government, Honors Spanish III, Honors Spanish IV.

Advanced Placement Classes: AP U.S. History, AP Government, AP Calculus, AP Statistics, AP Psychology, AP English Language, AP Literature, AP Seminar, AP Research, AP Physics, AP Biology, AP Spanish, and AP Studio Art.

Dual Credit: AP English Language, AP English Literature, AP Biology, AP Calculus, Pre-Calculus, College Algebra, The Process of College Composition, Advanced Rhetoric and Research, Introduction to Engineering, Human Anatomy and Physiology
